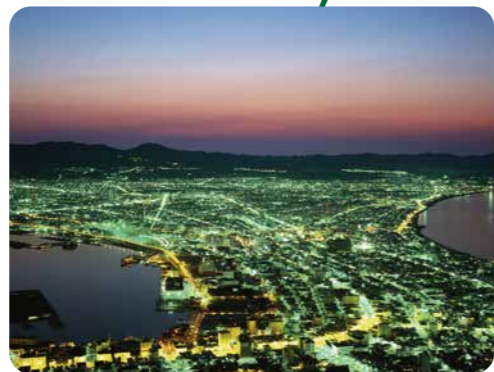


## Lake Toya

At popular Asahiyama Zoo, which is Japan's northernmost zoo, visitors can enjoy its creative way of showing lively animals.



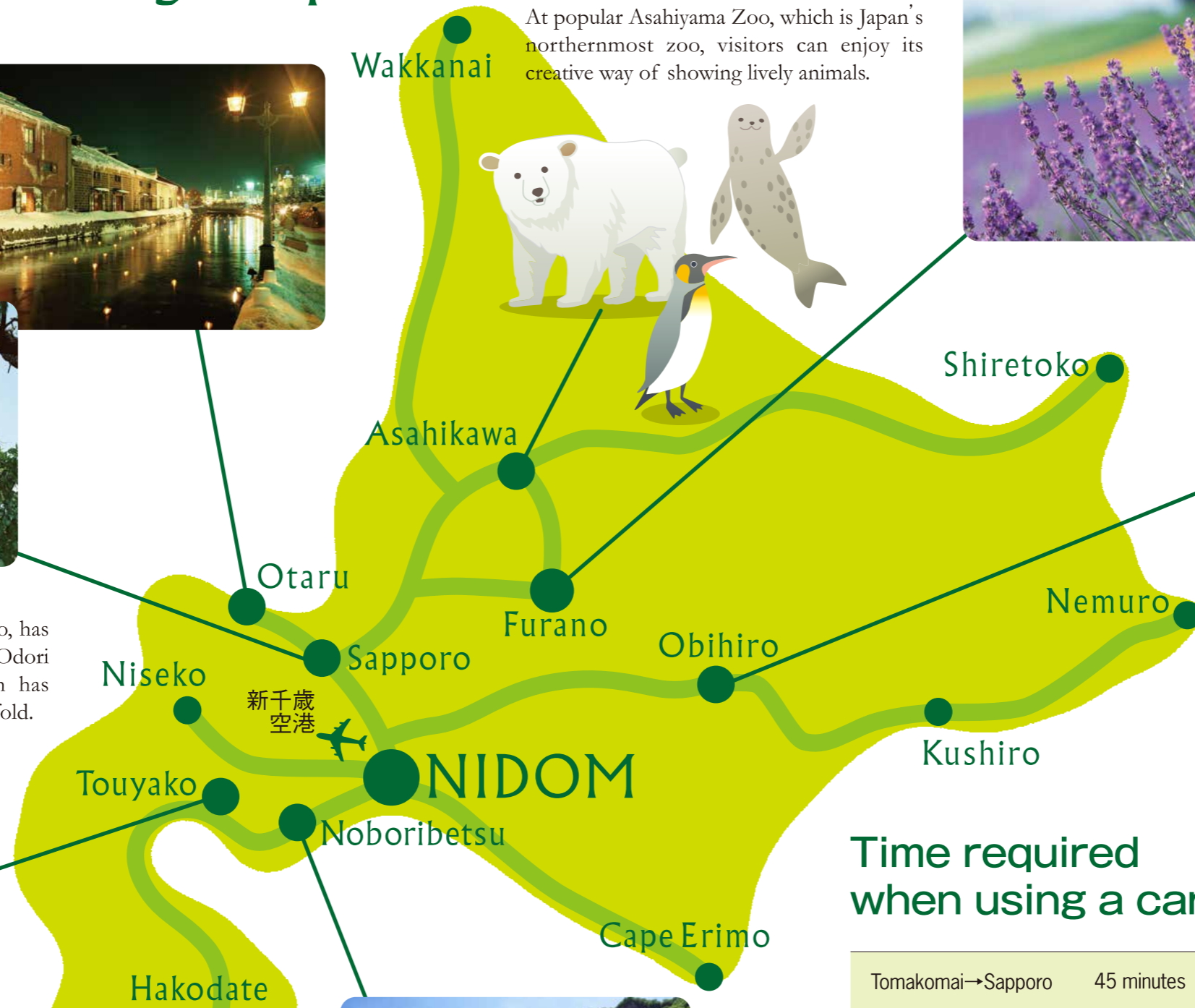
## Furano
